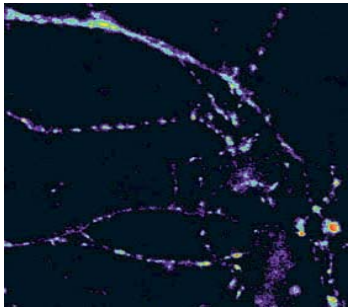




Oxford Networks Day
